A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF KING COUNTY WATER DISTRICT NO. 125, KING COUNTY, WASHINGTON ADOPTING THE 2004 EMERGENCY RESPONSE PLAN

WHEREAS, King County Water District No. 125, ("District") is a municipal corporation providing water utility services pursuant to Title 57 RCW; and

WHEREAS, in compliance with the Public Health Security and Bioterrorism Preparedness and Response Act of 2002 (the "Act") which required the District to review the vulnerability of its system to a terrorist attack or other intentional acts intended to substantially disrupt the ability of the system to provide a safe and reliable supply of drinking water, the District adopted a Vulnerability Assessment Report by Resolution No. 04 06 09-378 dated June 9, 2004, 2004; and

WHEREAS, the Act further requires completion of an Emergency Response Plan within 6 months of submittal of the Vulnerability Assessment Report to the United States Environmental Protection Agency; and

WHEREAS, in compliance with the Act, the District has completed an Emergency Response Plan, which includes as an appendix the Vulnerability Assessment Report; and

WHEREAS, the Emergency Response Plan and the Vulnerability Assessment Report are exempt from public inspection and copying pursuant to the provisions of RCW 42.17.310(1)(ww) and (ddd) and WAC 246-290-100; now, therefore

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of King County District No. 125, King County, Washington, as follows:

- The 2004 Emergency Response Plan is hereby approved and adopted and shall be effective the date set forth below.
- The 2004 Emergency Response Plan shall be exempt from public inspection and copying pursuant to RCW 42.17.310(1)(ww) and (ddd) and shall <u>not</u> be made available for public distribution in accordance with the requirements of WAC 246-290-100.
- District staff are hereby authorized and directed to provide certification of completion of the Emergency Response Plan to the United States Environmental Protection Agency as required by the Act.
