RESOLUTION NO. 81-11-11-88

(A resolution relating to "Conditions and Standards" and the requirement of a Performance-Maintenance Bond prior to construction of extensions to the District's main; and amending prior inconsistent resolutions.)

BE IT RESOLVED by the Commissioners of Water District No. 125, King County, that they hereby amend Resolution No. 78-10-11-24 relating to "Conditions and Standards", and the requirements of a Performance-Maintenance Bond prior to construction of extensions to the District's mains; and specifically amend CHECK LIST Developer's Extension item (B) thereof, to read as follows:

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the "Instructions for Obtaining Extensions to the Water System"; and specifically amend Extensions by Developers items (2) and (3) thereof, to read as follows:

- 2. Prior to the installation of water mains an "Application to Construct Extensions to the Distribution System of the District" must be signed by the Owner. At this time, if the Engineer of the Water District is to perform all engineering tasks (Form A), the Developer shall authorize the Engineer to proceed with design work and furnish him two copies of the Final Plat or Site Plan. Along with the Application (Form A or B) a \$1,000 cash deposit is required as evidence of good faith.
- 3. After the plans are approved and the Developer wishes to proceed with calling for bids, the Engineer and the Superintendent of the District will aid in any way possible in securing a suitable contractor to do this work. If a contractor is selected by the Developer, the Water District Engineer shall be immediately notified of this selection so that the Engineer will have time to interview the contractor regarding his qualifications to perform the contract. It is required that the Developer secure a Performance-Maintenance Bond guaranteeing the completion of this work, payment of bills, and guarantee of materials and workmanship for one year. It is required that only licensed contractors be

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that any resolutions inconsistent herewith, including Resolution No. 78-10-11-24 and 80-11-12-74, be and they are hereby amended accordingly.
